

Debriefing Workshop

Facilitating Effective Debriefing in Mannequin Simulation Programs

The use of mannequin simulation in healthcare is growing in popularity. Studies have shown that those who participate in simulation make fewer errors when placed in similar situations in real life than those who attended classroom instruction alone.

Provide a more enriched learning experience for your students, residents, and/or staff by participating in a workshop that will enable you to facilitate a productive, non-judgmental debriefing following mannequin simulation experiences.



In this workshop participants will be given an introduction to debriefing techniques with specific relation to debriefing high-fidelity mannequin simulations. Through didactics, discussion, mannequin simulations, and debriefing practice, participants will learn techniques of effective debriefing and be able to apply these skills in almost any situation.

Included are discussions on using Standardized Patients in mannequin simulation, how scenarios are written and used, and the role(s) of the Simulation Technicians within the scenarios and in debriefing.

Faculty using high-fidelity mannequin simulation are strongly encouraged to attend. Space is limited so please register early. Workshops consist of two ½ day sessions of 3 hours each or one 6-hour full day session.
