- Copies of awarded diploma/degree certificate or a transcript on which the award of the degree is indicated (Bachelor's degree or higher).

- If all prior coursework was done abroad, [English proficiency requirements](#) may apply

Personal Statement

- Please upload your completed answers to the posed questions, as a PDF document to your application

Personal Statement: please submit a personal statement (maximum 750 words for questions a and responding to the following prompts:

- a. Why are you interested in the CHPE program? Reflecting on your background, describe how the CHPE will help you advance your professional and personal goals.
- b. Our program involves collaborative work with individuals from different professional backgrounds, perspectives, and stages of their career. Briefly discuss your best assets you would bring to this context?

Resume/Curriculum Vitae

- Include information on your: employment; current professional roles and responsibilities; pertinent learning experiences not included on transcripts; teaching experiences; administrative experiences in health professions education; research and evaluation experiences; publications, presentations at professional meetings, or other evidence of scholarship; memberships in professional associations; and professional honors, awards, and distinctions.
