Dr. Felix Chau is currently an Associate Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Illinois at Chicago, Illinois Eye and Ear Infirmary (UIC-IEEI) Retina Service.

He graduated from Duke University with a Bachelor of Science in biomedical engineering in 1996. After graduating, he worked for Motorola, up until he decided to pursue a Medical Degree at the Medical School in Iowa. He completed his residency program at Duke University then completed his Retina fellowship at the University of Illinois Chicago in 2010.

Dr. Chau's work focuses on imaging studies of animal models of retinopathy of prematurity (ROP), analyzing SDOCT macular changes in sickle retinopathy patients, providing vitreoretinal care for Boston Keratoprosthesis patients, and those who are participating in the clinical trials. He also works with pediatric retina patients with conditions including ROP, Stickler's syndrome, and retinoblastoma.
