Important dates to keep in mind:

- First Spring Tuition Assessment January 2, 2017
- First Spring Disbursement January 2, 2017
- First Refund January 3, 2017
- First Spring Billing Due Date-February 28, 2017



Remember you MUST be registered for at least 6 credit hours in order to be eligible for any financial aid. FULL-TIME enrollment is consider 12 or more hours.
