Great News! The College of Medicine has a new option through the College of Medicine's Online Score and Grade Summary that allows you to audit your graduation requirements. Please visit the College of Medicine's Online Score and Grade Summary at <http://services.com.uic.edu/studentgrades> and click on "Student Pathway Audit Link." This page will display which courses you have scheduled and which graduation requirements they fulfill. There is a box that will indicate if you have met your pathway requirements.

Graduation Requirements:

In order to be a Spring 2016 graduate, you must complete the M4 clinical experiences listed below, passed the USMLE Step2 CK & CS exams and the UIC's Graduation Competencies exam, by June 18, 2016. **Please note**, College of Medicine procedures require you to schedule all weeks of clinical instruction by Monday, February 15, 2016, in order for the College to verify your eligibility to submit a Rank Order List and participate in the NRMP Match. Anyone lacking evidence of meeting graduation requirements must be pulled from the Match prior to the release of their Match results.
