### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The purpose of this program is to prepare students from disadvantaged backgrounds to be competitive applicants for graduate or professional school. The core experience for program participants will be a test preparation course for the GRE, DAT, or MCAT examinations. These courses are valued at \$1299-\$2999. In addition to strengthening test taking skills, participants will engage in different workshops designed to support them through the admissions process for graduate or professional school. This program is ideal for 1<sup>st</sup> time test takers as well as retakers. *It is free of charge for all participants.*

- To be competitive, applicant should have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 and science GPA of 2.5.
- Applicant must self-identify as coming from an economically and educationally disadvantaged background.
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident; documentation may be requested.
