**Policy: UIC Scrub Suit for OR**

**Disciplines: Anesthesia, Otolaryngology, Neurosurgery, OB/GYN, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Pediatric Dentistry, Oral/maxillofacial surgery, Surgery clerks/electives/sub specialties, and Urology**

Students who rotate in the above-mentioned clinical activities will spend some time in the Operating Room (OR). The Medical Center has started utilizing scrub dispensing machines for the OR to monitor the scrub assignment process. Access to the machine is controlled via I-card. Students who rotate in the disciplines listed above are mandated to complete/fax the Scrub Suit Request Form to Materials Management at least one (1) week prior to their clinical activity start date. All medical students are required to be in the scrub system before their first day in the OR.

**SCRUBS - ACCESS-CONTROLLED DISPENSER FORM REQUIRED PRIOR TO START**

Students on this rotation must have a completed [Scrub Suit Request Form](#) on file in Student Affairs. Student Affairs will submit documentation **at least one (1) week prior** to your clinical activity start date. **All medical students are required to be in the scrub system before their first day in the OR.**
