The AAFP Annual Leadership Forum was held April 23-29, 2009 in Kansas City, MO in conjunction with the AAFP National Conference of Special Constituencies held from April 23-24, 2009.

This leadership development program for AAFP Chapter elected leaders is designed to provide leadership training and an understanding of roles and responsibilities.
