Policy 10: Prohibited Objects Within Zone III

All loose metallic objects, electronics, and personal items must be removed from the subject and/or research staff before entering Zone III.

PROCEDURE

- A. Before admittance to Zone III, subjects must remove any loose metallic objects, electronics, and personal items from their person. (Examples of such objects include (but are not limited to) jewelry, watches, hair pins / clips, keys, pocket knives, pens, paper clips, coins, lighters, cell phones, wallet / credit cards, bus passes, etc.)
- B. All personal belongings shall be locked up within one of the lockers provided in the Zone II waiting area or left with the subject's family member.
- C. The MR research technologist will screen the subject again for such objects prior to entry into Zone IV.
