## Dr. Sean McCann

Please join the Department of Emergency Medicine in extending a warm welcome to Dr. Sean McCann.

Dr. McCann is an Assistant Professor of Clinical Emergency Medicine and Medical Toxicology. He completed undergrad (BS in neuroscience) and medical school at the University of Pittsburgh,

emergency medicine residency at Resurrection Medical Center and medical toxicology fellowship with the Toxikon Consortium, a joint program through UIC, Cook County Health and the Illinois Poison Center.

His fellowship research included projects addressing severe unintentional carbon monoxide poisoning, the impact of FDA packaging guidelines on loperamide abuse and misuse, severe methemoglobinemia secondary to sodium nitrite poisoning, morbidity and mortality associated with hyperthermia in poisoned patients, and patterns of dialysis utilization for lithium poisoning. He also has interests in botanical toxins, marine envenomations and intoxications, and the socioeconomic and racial disparities of lead poisoning in the United States.
