Subject: Resident Stipends in Fiscal/Academic Year 2021

The resident stipends will increase approximately 3.0% in the 2020-2021 fiscal/academic year. The new stipends by program year are as follows:

The reimbursement of dependent health insurance cost will continue as it was implemented effective July 1, 1999. A resident may select any health insurance plan offered by UIC, but any cost beyond the approved reimbursement amount will be borne by the resident. For the current fiscal year (FY20), the maximum reimbursement is \$96 for one dependent and \$132 for two or more dependents. This is subject to change in FY 2021.
