CME Credit and Accreditation:

Attendees requesting CME credits will need to either attend the virtual meeting in real time or view the on-demand video lectures, during the week of 20-26 February, 2021. Each day a link to an online evaluation form will be emailed to all attendees. For CME credits, evaluation forms will need to be submitted electronically by no later than the next day. The filled out forms will remain anonymous and all data (except for number of credit hours claimed) and comments on the forms will be pooled and remain anonymous to the speakers and IER organizers.

There is a \$50 processing fee per physician or optometrist attendee requesting CME credits. When you registered, this fee was charged if you requested CME credits. If you would like CME credits but did not request them when registering, please send email to ier@uic.edu. Also, make sure you submit the evaluation forms.

There are two mechanisms for earning CME credits. Both require registering for the course before the end of the live course on February 26th, 2021.

1. Attend the live event from February 20-26, 2021.
2. View the recorded on-demand content during the week of the live event (February 20-26, 2021).

Each day of the course, all registered attendees will be emailed a link to that day's electronic evaluation form, which will include a place for entering the number of CME credits you are requesting for that day.

Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity. The deadline for claiming CME credits is February 27th, 2021. Completion and submission of the evaluation form will record the number of CME credits you are requesting for that day. At the end of the meeting, each evaluation form you submitted for each day of attendance will be totaled and submitted to our CME office. Please allow up to 2 months to receive your CME certificate by email.

Completion of the form is requested of all attendees, regardless of whether they are requesting CME credits. Please complete the form as much as possible. Especially welcome are comments about the topics, speakers and if it met your expectations and/or how it can be improved. After completion of the form, please do not forget to click on the submit button to record your responses. Your responses are critical for maintaining the CME accreditation of the course and for lowering of the registration fees through independent medical education grants by providing feedback to sponsors.
